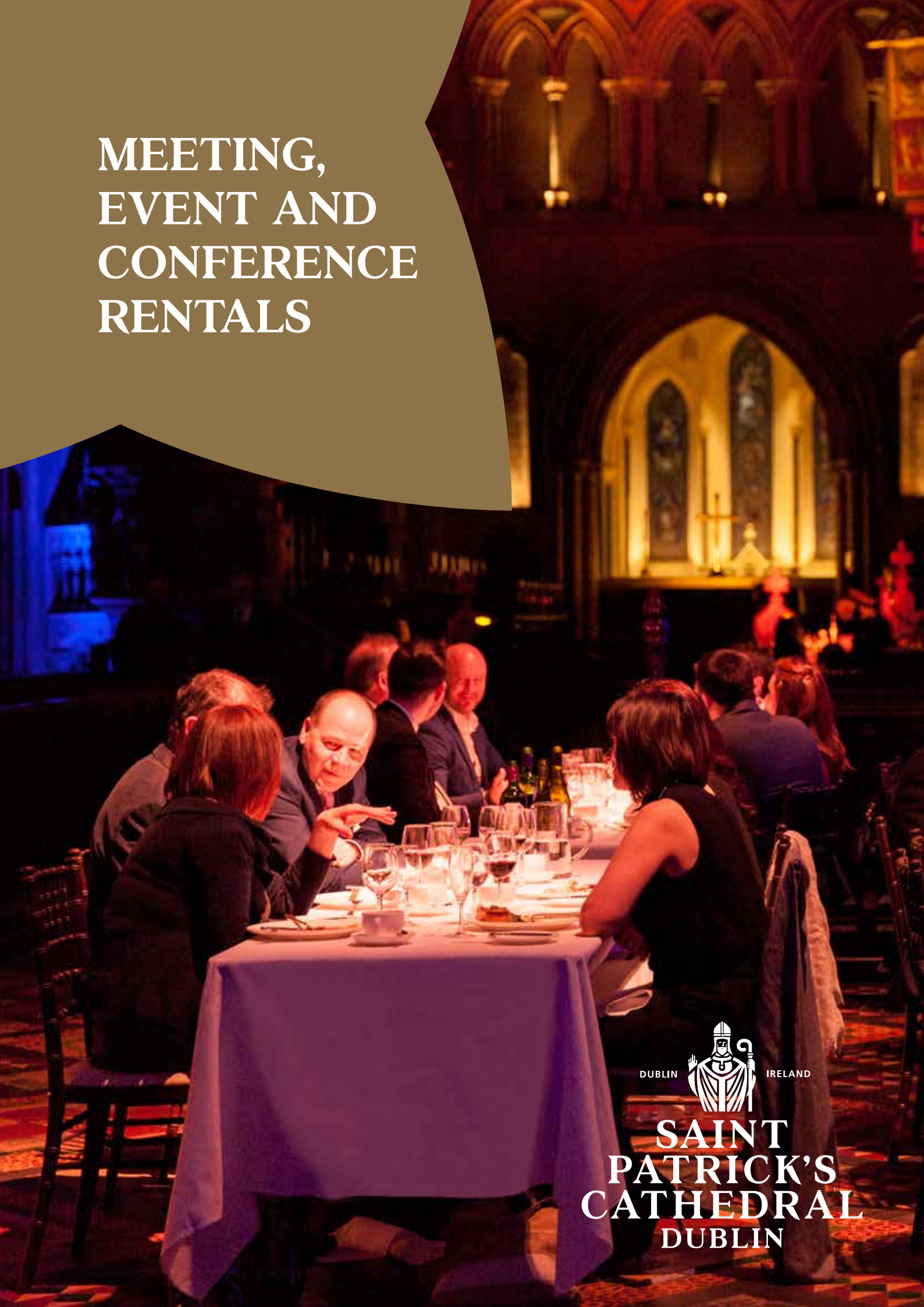


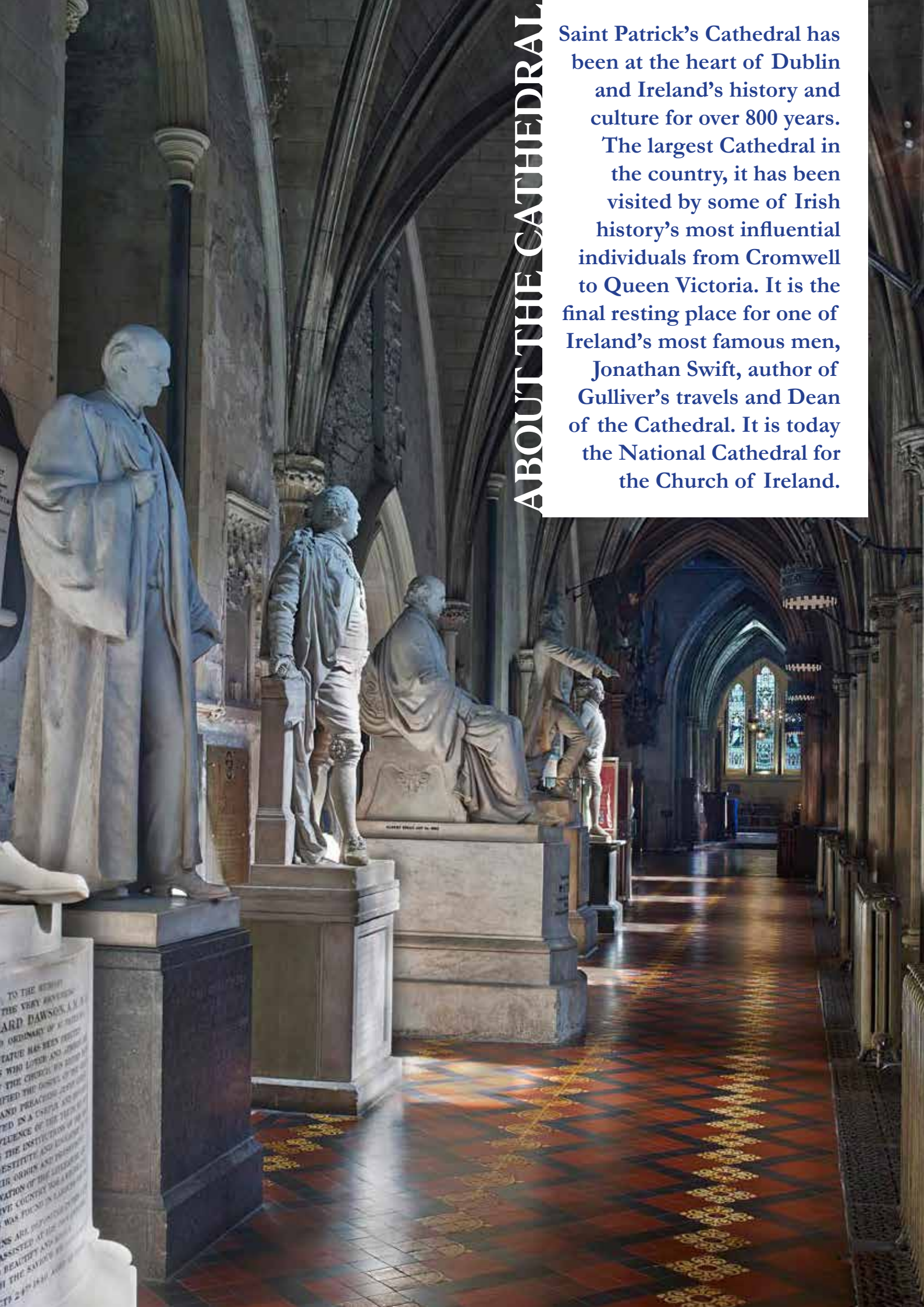

ABOUT THE CATHEDRAL

Saint Patrick's Cathedral has been at the heart of Dublin and Ireland's history and culture for over 800 years. The largest Cathedral in the country, it has been visited by some of Irish history's most influential individuals from Cromwell to Queen Victoria. It is the final resting place for one of Ireland's most famous men, Jonathan Swift, author of *Gulliver's travels* and Dean of the Cathedral. It is today the National Cathedral for the Church of Ireland.

THE LADY CHAPEL

Originally added to the Cathedral in 1270, the Lady Chapel was fully restored in 2012 and has an upgraded lighting and sound system.

THE NAVE

A commanding space for musical performances, gala dinners, presentations, and receptions, the nave is an excellent choice for large events.

CAPACITY:	Seated presentation	500 guests without repeater screens; 1,200 with

	Standing cocktail reception	1,000 guests
