

Access at wallacespace Spitalfields

Wallacespace Spitalfields is one of our most accessible buildings.

The front door has step free entry and is 145cm wide. The door does not have assisted entry but there are staff in the reception area at all times to be on hand or answer any questions.



The caffé for breakfast and lunch is on the fourth floor and is accessible via a lift. There are also accessible loos on the first, second and third floors for your convenience. We have are breakout spaces on all floors with a variety of teas, coffee and plenty of snacks.

There is a lift to all floors and they are fairly easy to navigate as there are no steps. The width of the door to access the lift is 78cm. Once you're in, the lift is 110cm x 145cm. The maximum weight capacity is 630kg. The buttons light up and there is audio to let you know which floor you are on

The doors to access our meeting rooms are 87cm wide. The loo doors are 76cm wide.

Please let us know in advance if you'll need a hearing loop.
